The Haunting of Vancouver Island

Supernatural Encounters with the Other Side

Shanon Sinn

A compelling investigation into supernatural events and local lore on Vancouver Island.

Vancouver Island is known worldwide for its arresting natural beauty, but those who live here know that it is also imbued with a palpable supernatural energy. Researcher Shanon Sinn found his curiosity piqued by stories of mysterious sightings on the island—ghosts, sasquatches, sea serpents—but he was disappointed in the sensational and sometimes disrespectful way they were being retold or revised. Acting on his desire to transform these stories from unsubstantiated gossip to thoroughly researched accounts, Sinn uncovered fascinating details, identified historical inconsistencies, and now retells these encounters as accurately as possible.

Investigating 25 spellbinding tales that wind their way from the south end of the island to the north, Sinn explored hauntings in cities, in the forest, and on isolated logging roads. In addition to visiting castles, inns, and cemeteries, he followed the trails of spirits glimpsed on mountaintops, beaches, and water, and visited Heriot Bay Inn on Quadra Island and the Schooner Restaurant in Tofino to personally scrutinize reports of hauntings. Featuring First Nations stories from each of the three Indigenous groups who call Vancouver Island home—the Coast Salish, the Nuuchahnulth, and the Kwakwaka'wakw—the book includes an interview with Hereditary Chief James Swan of Ahousaht.

Shanon Sinn is a member of the British Columbia Ghosts & Hauntings Research Society (BCGHRs) and Paranormal Studies and Inquiries Canada (PSICAN), and he researches folklore and hauntings from a journalistic perspective. Sinn is also an infantry veteran, aspiring photographer, forager, and stand-up paddle boarder. He is currently enrolled in the Vancouver Island University Creative Writing Program, and was recently awarded the Barry Broadfoot Award for Journalism. Find out more about him at shanonsinn.com.

The third book in the popular Lane Winslow mystery series by an author the *Globe and Mail* has called a “writer to watch.”

It's early spring of 1947 in idyllic King's Cove, and the Hughes ladies, *mere et filles*, are gardening and sorting through the jars of food that have been put up for the winter. But while cleaning up after the roof of their root cellar has caved in slightly, they are horrified to discover a small skeletal hand embedded in the mess. Panicked, they call Lane Winslow, the ex-British secret service agent, and, not without some misgivings about the state of their tense relationship, Lane calls Inspector Darling.

Before long the police crew discover the body of a young child buried almost 40 years before. Who is the child, and why has it not been buried in the local cemetery? Inspector Darling, already busy dealing with a teenage girl who has gone on a destructive rampage at a local mill, asks Lane for help in unearthing the long-forgotten secrets of the early life of the tiny town, and the identity of the long-forgotten child.

This delightful new historical mystery series will appeal to fans of Maisie Dobbs and Bess Crawford.

Your Heart Is the Size of Your Fist

A Doctor Reflects on Ten Years at a Refugee Clinic

Martina Scholtens

An absorbing and touching read, this collection of true stories is the first book by a Canadian doctor on the topic of refugee health.

Your Heart Is the Size of Your Fist draws readers into the complicated, poignant, and often-overlooked daily happenings of a busy urban medical clinic for refugees.

An Iraqi journalist whose son has been murdered develops post-traumatic stress disorder and mourns his loss of vocation. A Congolese woman refuses antiretroviral treatment for her new HIV diagnosis, and instead places her trust in Jesus. Two conservative Muslim Iraqi women are inadvertently exposed to pornography when a doctor uses Google Images to supplement a medical discussion. By turns humorous, distressing, and moving, these stories offer insight into the people seeking a new life in Canada while navigating poverty, language barriers, and Canadian neighbours who aren't always friendly.

This collection is filled with hope and humour, and is a deeply moving portrait of how one doctor attempts to provide quality care and advocacy for patients while remaining culturally sensitive, even as she wrestles with guilt, awareness of her own privilege, and vicarious trauma.

In the spirit of Louise Aronson and Atul Gawande, Scholtens's writing explores the transformative moments in which a clinical doctor-patient relationship becomes a profound human-human connection.

Dr. Martina Scholtens is a clinical instructor with the Faculty of Medicine at the University of British Columbia, and worked at the province's only refugee clinic for ten years, caring for patients from around the globe. The recipient of the Mimi Divinsky Award for History and Narrative in Family Medicine (2016), she is currently completing her MA in Public Health. Scholtens is a member of the Canadian Doctors for Refugee Care, has done extensive advocacy work around federal health insurance for refugees, and has a special interest in Narrative Medicine. 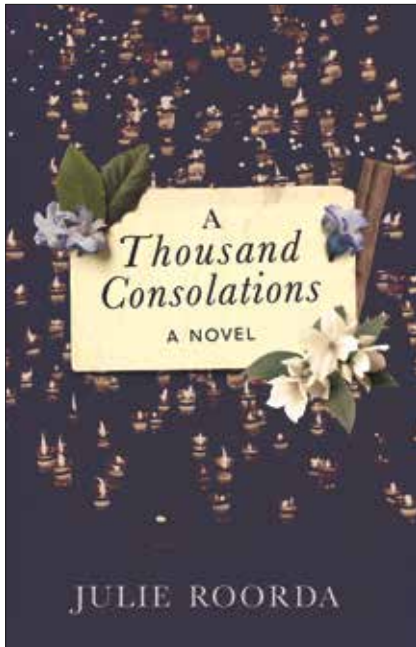

A Thousand Consolations

Moving, entertaining, and witty, *A Thousand Consolations* is a literary romantic comedy for fans of David Nicholls's *Us* and Emma Straub's *Modern Lovers*.

Paula doesn't put much faith in the candles she designs for her customers, which promise to cure everything from unrequited love to ingrown toenails; it's just a business she started after her husband's untimely death put an end to their joint dream of a career on the stage. Believing she may have somehow contributed to Teddy's illness, Paula is too crippled by guilt to pursue the dream of acting on her own, and too bitter to believe she'll ever be happy again.

Then she meets Héctor, a former concert pianist seeking refuge from the Mexican narcos who severed his fingers and threatened worse. With great charm and wit, Héctor seduces her into believing in a life in which hope coexists with disappointment, happiness with loss. Paula begins to believe that love is a possibility after all. But will Héctor be allowed to remain in Canada, or be sent back to an unknown fate?

A Thousand Consolations is a surprisingly funny novel in which virtuosity, philosophy, and humour endure despite the modern blights of refugee politics and the threat of narcoterrorism.

Julie Roorda is the author of three volumes of poetry, a collection of stories, and a novel for young adults. Her fiction has appeared in periodicals across Canada, including *The Fiddlehead* and *The New Quarterly*. Her story "How to Tell if Your Frog is Dead" was included in the 2014 Journey Prize Anthology. She lives in Toronto.

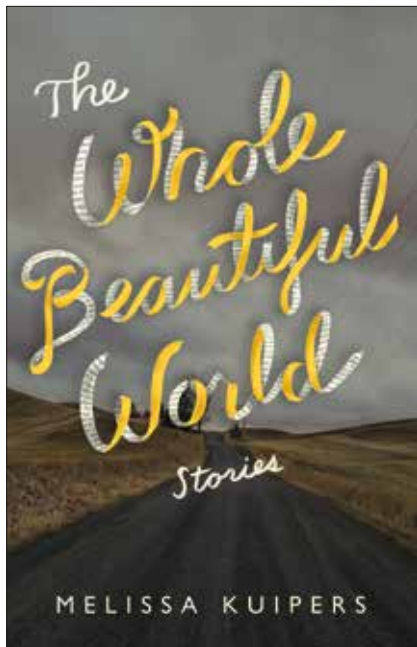

The Whole Beautiful World

Stories

Melissa Kuipers

Original, witty, and subtle, these stories feature characters who must navigate life in a small town, and will appeal to fans of Miriam Toews and Kathleen Winter.

These beautifully crafted short stories feature complex characters whose internal struggles manifest themselves in their most intimate relationships, revealed by a writer with a compassionate eye.

A young woman watches her social sphere deteriorate after her boyfriend's roughhousing leads to his best friend's tragic paralysis. Childhood sweethearts, finally united later in life, find that they are not the soulmates they believed themselves to be. When her mother becomes depressed after a miscarriage, a daughter takes on the role of caregiver.

Set in fictional small rural towns, these stories explore young people growing up against a religious backdrop, mothers who balk at society's imposed identities, and individuals struggling with their roles within their families as they navigate sexuality, suffering, and shame. These characters are blunt and sometimes obsessive as they tell their stories, but bravely optimistic as they strive to be the best versions of themselves.

As her characters struggle to discern deception from reality, Kuipers' understated style and detailed observation is on full display.

Melissa Kuipers was born and raised on an egg farm in Aylmer, Ontario, and grew up in a tight-knit Dutch-Canadian Christian community. She holds an MA in English in the Field of Creative Writing at the University of Toronto. She has been published in the *Rusty Toque*, *Grain*, *Joyland*, *Ryga*, *Qwerty*, and the *Puritan*. Melissa lives in Hamilton, Ontario, with her husband, Mark, and infant son, Elliott.

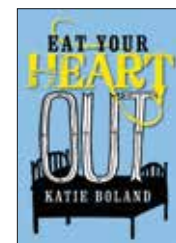

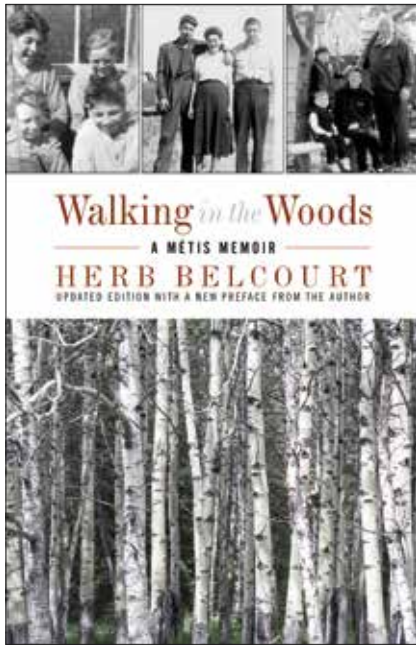

Walking in the Woods

A Métis Memoir

Herb Belcourt

An updated edition of Herb Belcourt's remarkable life story with a brand new foreword by the author.

The eldest of ten children, Herb Belcourt grew up in a small log home near the Métis settlement of Lac Ste. Anne during the Depression. His father purchased furs from local First Nations and Métis trappers and, with arduous work, began a family fur trading business that survives to this day. When Belcourt left home at 15 to become a labourer in coal mines and sawmills, his father told him to save his money so he could work for himself. Over the next three decades, Belcourt founded a number of small Alberta businesses that prospered and eventually enabled him to make significant contributions to the Métis community in Alberta.

Belcourt has devoted over 30 years of his life to improving access to affordable housing and further education for Aboriginal Albertans. In 1971, he co-founded Canative Housing Corporation, a non-profit agency charged with providing homes for urban Aboriginal people who confronted housing discrimination in Edmonton and Calgary. In 2004, Belcourt and his colleagues established the Belcourt Brosseau Métis Awards Fund, a \$13-million endowment with a mandate to support the educational dreams of Métis youth and mature students in Alberta and to make a permanent difference in the lives of Métis Albertans.

Herb Belcourt is an entrepreneur and philanthropist from Lac Ste. Anne, Alberta. He was awarded an honorary doctorate of laws by the University of Alberta in 2001, and was also the recipient of a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Canadian Council for Aboriginal Business in 2016. He has been inducted into both Alberta's Hall of Fame and Edmonton's Hall of Fame, and January 20 was recently declared Herb Belcourt Day in Sherwood Park, Alberta.
